

CLINICAL CARDIOLOGY

Eduard Apetrei Calisto Medical Publishing House, 2015, Bucharest

The volume "Clinical Cardiology" published in 2015 in Calisto Medical Publishing House, edited by Professor Eduard Apetrei (member of the Academy of Medical Sciences), is an important event, not only by the volume of the book (1250 two columns and dense page), by the number (62 chapters small, medium, large or very large chapters according with the importance of topic), but also by the high number of contributors: 79 authors from several university centers. The co-ordinator of the book took care for the unitary character of the material, each chapter ending with "A Look to the Future", and a summary in Romanian and in English. The references, which can be not than selective and quoted in the text, have been printed with a letter-7 (about 100 references on the two columns of each page), reserving enough space for the most detailed and up-to-date description of the specific issues of each chapter. The well-chosen illustrations, where needed in color images, greatly increases their informative value. You can appreciate the quality of the paper, thin, but dense enough to prevent the writing on the other side of the paper. This is why the volume is "hard" not only in its content but also in its weight, which probably exceeds 4 kg. Compared with other similar treatises, it looks as good as those published in reputed international publishers.
