Dr. Andreas Wild is consulting, after retiring from the position of Executive Director of the ECSEL Joint Undertaking, a public – private partnership on nanoelectronics, embedded software and smart system integration established as an autonomous European Union body, that followed the ENIAC JU.

His work in European institutions has been recognized with the *Special Service Award 2017* by SEMI Europe. Previously, he was the European R&D Director for Freescale Semiconductor and Motorola Semiconductor Products Sector; before that, he managed Motorola SPS R&D laboratories in U.S.A. and Latin America.

He has an MS degree from the University *Politehnica* and a Ph.D. degree from the Institute of Atomic Physics, both in Bucharest, Romania. He authored 36 patents and more than 75 technical publications.
